- **Website**

Shout out to the MASSES about 2017 Registration being Open, Dick's Day/Night, Tigers Night, All Star Dates, and SLHS Boys Clinics. Also let all know of regular registration ending on March 5 and Late registration beginning on March 6 with a \$35.00 late fee added on to regular registration. Send out twice a week and three times on last week before Late Registration Kicks In.

Jen and Laura will start to register all SLJL Board Members on Blue Sombrero so they all receive SLJL communication.

- **Fields/Equipment**

Park's & Rec gave presentation to City Council in development of Volunteer Park. They suggested that the development be done in phases. Each phase would need design approval from all involved. The City Council approved this plan unanimously. The design of Phase 1 which includes two baseball fields has been approved at a cost of \$5,000,000.

Eagle Scout project for Dugout Roofs is holding due to finances.

Dean reported at June 8 meeting that Lyon Twp has approved the design of 2 baseball/softball fields and 1 multipurpose field at Atchison Park. Lyon Twp has approved the expenditure of \$8,500 for engineering design. Sean O'Neil reported that all are waiting for engineering survey to be completed. Ralph and Dean attended meeting with Lyon Twp and engineers designing 2, 200 ft baseball fields. Still items to be worked out but tentative breaking ground in Spring of 2017. The 2 baseball fields at Atchison behind Fire Department are out for bid with completion scheduled for 2017. Discussion in Lyon Twp concerning possible building of 3rd baseball field. SLJL Board stated that Twp board must approach SLJL to discuss possible funding. Atchison drawings to be completed week of Jan 30, then job will be sent out for bids. The meeting to discuss drawings and to start bid process is being pushed out to week of Feb 13 for Lyon Twp and the SLJL to discuss. Ralph, Paul, Dean, Guido, and Randy attended design review of 2 fields. Discussion went well and it was made clear we expected to be working on 2-200 ft fields. Engineer made notes and will set up meeting to review updates in near future.

Dean to put together proposal for improving Bartlett field in 2017. Parks and Rec approaching SLJL about use of Bartlett for Wed/Fri for Adult Softball Leagues. Possibly giving SLJL Volunteer for Tuesdays. Deb & Dean to meet with Don of Parks and Rec to discuss improvements to be made at Bartlett. Parks & Rec interested in partnering with SLJL on improvements. Finances unknown at this time. Deb also stated a new large box is needed at Bartlett.

Schools will be continuing the work this summer on parking lots and school maintenance. Centennial parking lots to be closed for 4 weeks. Sayre fields to be closed for all summer. More to come on these situations as winter continues. SLHS fields will be open all year. A miscommunication caused us to believe they may be closed but they will be open.

SLHS coaches requested Batting Cages for both Softball and Baseball Fields. Ralph to discuss with coaches as to what the teams will bring to the

table towards the cost of these Cages. SLJL will not fund the complete projects. Must be a partnership to get these done.

Dan will provide quantity, sizes needed, and pricing of Softballs for 2017 season. Still working on pricing. Jason at DSG is looking into price and quality of Soft Balls that DSG can provide SLJL.

Need to check with Lyon Twp as to when we can strip infield of existing dirt and move that to warning tracks and then spread appropriate infield material.

Ralph & Irv with a couple of helpers rebuilt the Bartlett Storage Room last weekend. Now the inventory needs to be organized and stored.

Deb needs to order Brooms, 5 Sets of Bases, and 4 new Drags for upcoming season. Do not need Safety Bases. New bases are needed for Brummer, Salem, 9 Mile, and SLHS Boy's fields. The Golf Cart needs to go in for yearly checkup. Walt will provide Deb with new First Aid Kits he has.

- **Scheduling**

Jen to get Ken all school Blackout Dates so Ken can get Spring scheduling started.

Need to reschedule games scheduled at Atchison on Kite Day. We need to avoid those fields each year on Kite Day.

Schedule games on Flag Day next year after 1:00 pm. This will allow us to not lose the whole day due to Flag Day Parade.

All future Championship Games need to be at SLHS except for Koufax. Reese (Varsity) and Mays (JV) same night same time. Majors (Varsity) and Minors (JV) same night same time. All of these should be scheduled for Monday and Tuesday of All Star Week.

New Girl's Minis division to play on Tuesday and Thursday. May need to schedule divisions for 3 games a week in Spring due to school closures for work on schools and parking lots. More to come during winter.

- **T-Ball Day**

For 2017 need to remove one Bounce House and add large tent with tables and chairs. Suggestion is to have bounce houses and tent in centerfield of both fields.

Have Face Painters and Balloon Artists start at end of first games in 2017.

Move start time of first game later instead of 9:00 am start.

Need to put together flier describing events on T-Ball Day for 2017.

All Travel Players must register thru Blue Sombrero to pay SLJL \$30.00 field fee. 222 Travel Players to date have registered. Laura to keep Dean and Bryan up to date on the progress of these registrations.
